Silver Chalice Epithermal Gold & Silver Project - Alaska

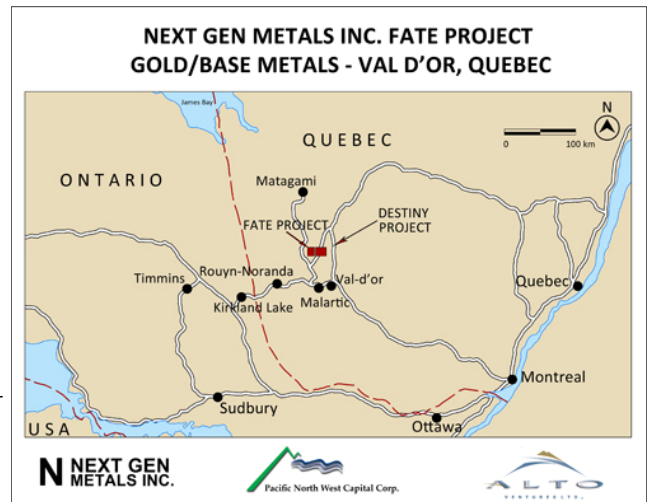
Next Gen has reached an agreement with Anglo Alaska Gold Corp., a privately owned Alaska Corporation to acquire a 100% interest in the Silver Chalice epithermal gold/silver project consisting of 31 State of Alaska mining claims for 4,960 acres, located in west-central Alaska approximately 345 miles northwest of Anchorage and 330 miles west southwest of Fairbanks.

2011 Work Program

Based on preliminary field, laboratory and literature studies completed to date, the Company is planning an extensive 2011 exploration program consisting of follow up mapping, trenching, rock/soil sampling and geochemical work to identify targets for a proposed 2,000 metre diamond drill program.
